We are so thankful for the many people who have already given us time, finances and materials to make this facility for the guys a reality.

And of course, this is the time of year that a great portion of my energy is spent in making plans for this summer's teams, booking airline flights, contacting pastors and missionaries, and planning the costs and schedules for each team. Planning one team takes time, but planning three or more teams is a major feat. It is only by the Lord's guidance and strength that it all comes together each year so smoothly.

The NYC guy's team will be traveling during May. The Western team will be taking the bus during part of May and June to Kansas, Wyoming, Utah, and Arizona, where we are planning special church services, door to door work, VBS, youth meetings, meetings in parks, and church planting. Then another team will be going to New Zealand in July and August, where they will be working with several pastors and missionaries, doing many of the same things we will be doing out West. The New Zealand team will also be helping with a family camp. We are looking forward to a fantastic summer. Please pray that many lives will be touched through MTT Ministries.
